

THE IMPORTANCE OF TONSILLECTOMY IN THE TREATMENT OF PERITONSILLAR ABSCESS

ABSTRACT

Aim: The main purpose of this article is to demonstrating of the effectiveness and safety of the tonsillectomy in the treatment of the peritonsillar abscess. Peritonsillar abscess (PTA) is one of the most common complications of acute tonsillitis, which does not pass without emergency surgery. And therefore tonsillectomy is important in the treatment of PTA.

Material and Methods: During the 2018-2019 years in hospital SCH-№1 base of the TIPME, 34 patients were treated with a diagnosis of PTA. Of these, 18 persons are men and 16 persons are women. This indicator includes patients from the age of 18 to 50 years. Patients had dysphagia, trismus, pain in the area of the jaw and throat when the mouth opened, one of the main symptoms of PTA. We are in all of these patients, tonsillectomy surgical procedure was performed.

Results: When we did PTA puncture, purulent detachment was obtained, purulent detachment was bacteriologically examined and tonsillectomy was performed in all patients. Then patients were prescribed general antibacterial therapy. Tonsillectomy at the PTA showed such a result that we observed rapid, effective healing of patients.

Conclusion: In conclusion, it should be said that tonsillectomy surgical procedure in PTA helps patients to recover safely and effectively.
